What to wear and bring

- * Sturdy shoes
- * Work gloves
- * 2 Liters of water or more to carry with you. Additional water will be available on-site
- Sun protection (wide brim hat, loose clothing that covers your limbs, sun screen)
- Snacks and Lunches
- Small pack to carry lunch, etc
- Tweezers or needle nose pliers for extracting splinters
- Clothing appropriate to the forecasted weather (i.e., rain gear)
 - Be aware that the nights can be cool, or even cold – bring some warm clothing
- Long pants and shirt sleeves are recommended for work
- Camping equipment, camp chair
- VOAz provided meals do not include eating utensils, plates or cups

* *Items are required in order to participate. Work gloves may be available on a first come, first serve basis.*

* *A minor who is not accompanied by a parent or guardian must bring a completed Waiver and Medical Release for Minor.*

Physical requirements to participate

This event involves removing vegetation and is listed as moderate. Consideration should be given to the altitude at the North Rim which is at 7800ft to 8000ft.

How to get there

From Flagstaff take Rte 89 N toward Page. About 30 miles south of Page watch for Rte 89A and take it to Jacob Lake. Then take Hwy 67 S to the Grand Canyon. Show your **park entrance/camping pass** at the gate to get free entry; the permit will be sent to all participants via email.
